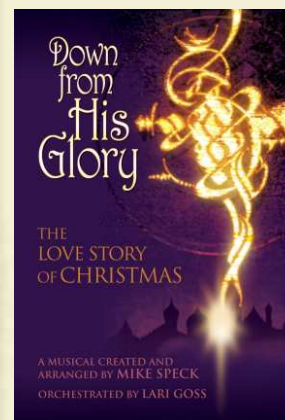
DiscipleNow Weekend Mission Trip
